
Identify stressful areas in parent—adolescent interactions

Appropriate for parents of adolescents ages 11 to 19 years. Administration time is 20 minutes. Available in paper and pencil or online administration and scoring via PARiConnect.

The **Uniform Child Custody Evaluation System (UCCES)** is a uniform custody evaluation procedure that provides a comprehensive, systematic method for gathering data and organizing the information necessary to determine a child's (ages 1 to 17 years) best interest. Administration time varies. Available in paper and pencil.




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Screen for physical child abuse

The **Child Abuse Potential Inventory (CAPI)** is a screening tool for the detection of physical child abuse to be used by protective services workers in their investigations of reported child abuse cases. Appropriate for parent or primary caregivers ages 18 to 99 years. Administration time is 15 minutes. Available in paper and pencil and for **online administration and scoring via PARiConnect**.
