


Identify the probability of a substance dependence disorder

The Adult Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory-4 (SASSI-4)

helps identify the probability of substance dependence and substance abuse disorders. It provides information to help you select appropriate treatment. The SASSI-4 includes a prescription drug scale and identifies the presence or absence of a substance abuse disorder even when other psychological symptoms are present.

Distinguish an adolescent's substance abuse disorder from other psychological disorders

The Adolescent Substance Abuse Subtle Screening Inventory (SASSI-A3)

distinguishes likely substance use disorders from other psychological disorders in individuals age 12–18 years, even when other psychological symptoms are present. New items reflect current teen alcohol and drug use patterns, as well as a brief new scale designed to identify individuals likely to be abusing prescription medications.
